2011 Recruitment

Several of our US partner hospitals are continuing to recruit international nurses as they expect staff shortages to prevail over the coming years. This demonstrates that they expect there to be changes to the immigration process at some point – although no-one knows exactly when!

With fewer US recruiters operating in the UK, interviewers are being more selective and only considering candidates with NCLEX and relevant UK nursing experience.

Referrals

Don't forget we will pay you £150 for every nurse you refer to us, who subsequently receives a job offer from a US hospital. We do have some hospitals interviewing in the first few months of next year so anyone with NCLEX could receive a job offer within a few months.
